

Chinese Students coming to Copley

On Monday 26th June we will be welcoming 30 Y5 and Y6 Chinese students to Copley and New Road schools. They will be with us alongside 6 teaching staff until Thursday 29th June.

The students and teachers are from the Fushan Foreign Language Primary School, Pudong/Shanghai, the school I visited in September 2015 to study their approaches to maths.

The students are going to be split between Copley and New Road so we will be hosting 15 here. They will be spending time in all classes at the school taking part in our usual lessons and timetable of the school. They particularly want to see how we teach PE, Art and DT but also want to observe our literacy and numeracy lessons.

We will be ending the four day visit with a party in the park for all the Chinese visitors with our Y5 and Y6 pupils up at Manor Heath.

We are really looking forward to meeting the students and spending the four days with them, showing them, and celebrating what our system is all about in the UK.
