Bat Walk.....

The walk called Bats on the Escarpment will take place on Albert Promenade on Friday 22nd September from 7pm (until around 8pm - 8.30pm). It is done specifically on a Friday in the hope families might attend and allow children to stay up a little later at the end of the week.

The session is led by staff from Calderdale Countryside Service and will take the form of a short talk (with special guest Mr Bat!) followed by a walk through the woodlands of Scarr Wood (and possibly Long Wood) looking and listening for bats (with bat detectors) and other nocturnal wildlife. It is hoped the session will introduce people to some of the hidden wildlife of the area - but that is dependant on the bats and the weather!
