

Copley Bridge and Pedestrian Safety

Anyone who has tried to walk up or down to school this week will be fully aware of the problems pedestrians are having as the traffic is building up at peak times around the



bridge.

Our parents have been very pro-active with the petition that was presented to the council last term. As a result, several long term options are currently being studied by the council to try and find a safer way for our families to get to and from school.

I have spoken with the Crossing patrol officer, Gary Waldron this week to see if there is any possibility or feasibility in deploying a crossing patrol up by the bridge. Gary visited the problem area on Wednesday morning at peak time to see for himself the issues we are all raising. I will let you know of any developments in this area as soon as I have them.

I have also asked him to look at the timings of the traffic lights at the bottom of the hill to see if a delay can be placed after the red light and before the green man flashes to allow for those inconsiderate and dangerous drivers who are jumping the red light at the last minute. If you recall last term we had two near misses with our pupils because of this issue.
