Term Time holidays and unauthorised absences.

A few parents have asked recently for clarification on the issues of penalty notices if they choose to take their child on holiday during term time. This only applies when the school has deemed the situation does not qualify for our exceptional circumstances category. This is the latest guidance from Calderdale Council.

Penalty Notices can be issued if any of the following three conditions applies:

- A pupil has accrued at least five consecutive days of unauthorised leave of absence (holiday in term time)
- A pupil has accrued at least 5 days or 10 sessions of unauthorised absence in any 6 week period (longer periods can be considered)
- A pupil has accrued a level of absence that the governing body deem to be evidence of a failure to attend regularly (any absence of less than 5 days is unlikely to be able to be prosecuted and therefore a Penalty Notice would be unlikely to be issued by the Local Authority)

A Penalty Notice is fixed at a fine of £120 which the recipient has 28 days to pay. The fine is payable to the council not the school.
